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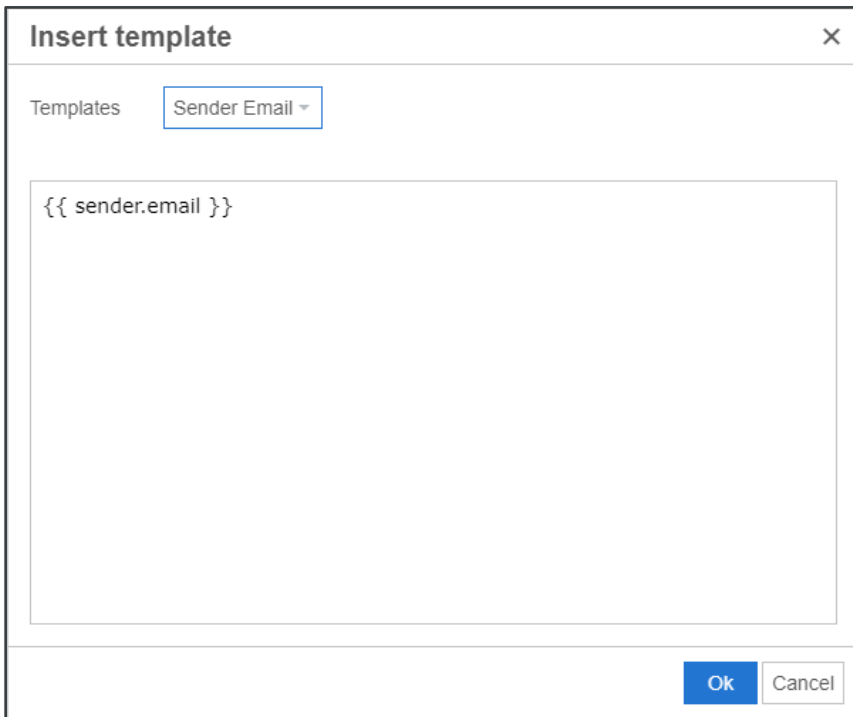
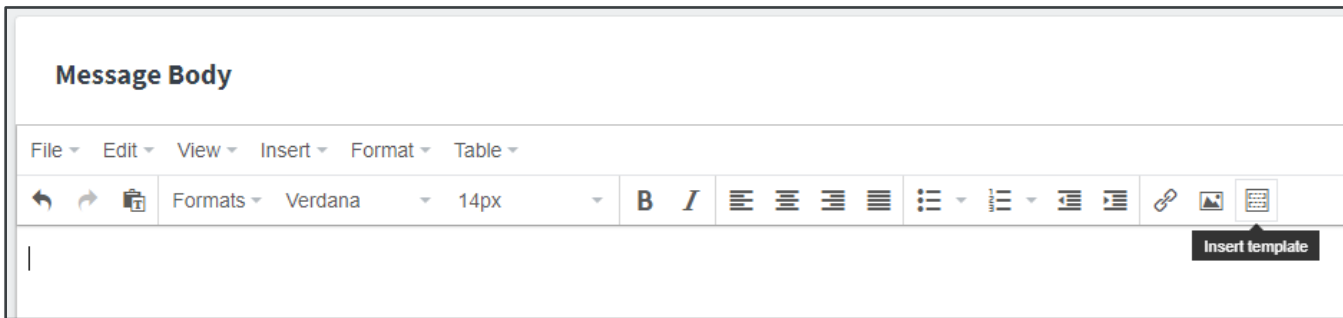
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## Introduction

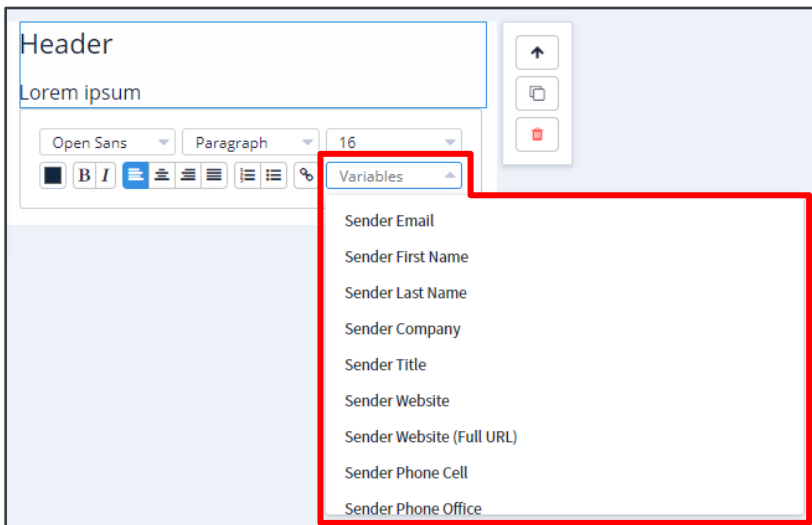
You can use placeholder tags in email templates to allow you to make use of data associated with your account, such as loan or contact information for your contacts, to customize messages. Placeholders in the body of an email will populate the appropriate data when the email is sent.

If a placeholder refers to a field that has been left blank, nothing (not even whitespace) will be populated at the placeholder’s location when the email is sent. It would appear to the recipient as if nothing had been typed at that location. (They will never see the placeholder code.)

You can type the placeholders listed in the tables below directly into an email template or select them from the drop-down menu in the **Insert template** dialog box.



If you are using the email builder feature, you can insert a placeholder by selecting it from the **Variables** drop-down in the text editing toolbar. You can locate a placeholder by typing in the box to filter the list.





# Sender, Co-Marketer, and Recipient Placeholders

The placeholders in the following sections populate data from user, organization, or contact records. They can be used in emails sent directly or by actions in an auto-campaign.

## Sender Placeholders

These placeholders populate from data provided for the user account of the person sending an email. Contact information is drawn from the fields on the Account Settings page. Licensing information, links, and profile image are drawn from the fields on the Marketing Profile Settings page. The email signature is defined on the Email Settings page.

If both the sender and the co-marketer belong to the same organization, then both sets of placeholders will populate the same information.

The option to select a co-marketer is available when adding an email campaign to a contact or under Message Settings when sending an email directly. If the message contains no co-marketer (or co-marketer organization) placeholders, the option is not shown.

## Loan Data Placeholders

The placeholders in the following sections populate data from a loan record. They must be used with in emails sent by event-driven actions in an auto-campaign. Specifically, you must set the Driving Event to **Loan Status**

**Saved/Updated.** In that case, the loan whose status changes will be used to provide the data referenced by the placeholder.

You can optionally set one or more conditions so that the event is triggered only when a loan is given a specified status. If you do not set any conditions, the action will be triggered by any change to a loan status.

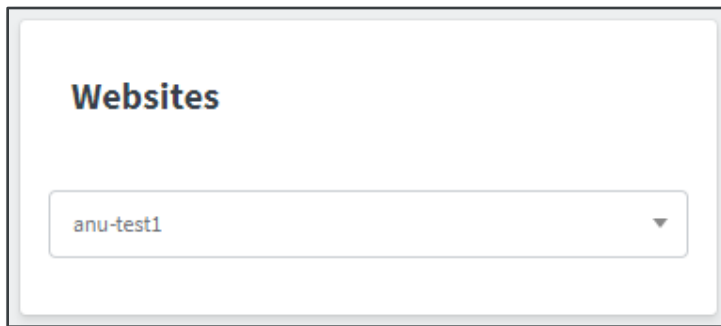

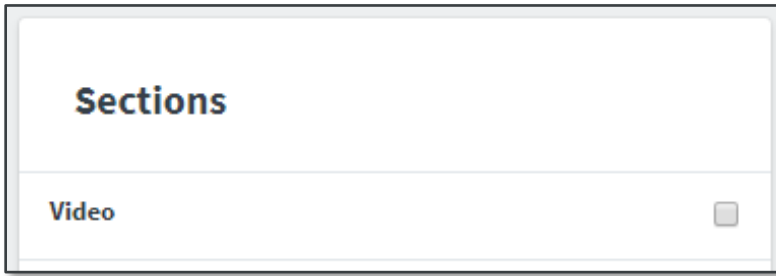

## Video Placeholders

These placeholders populate from a marketing video (such as BombBomb) specified by the user before sending the email. When creating an email template with video placeholders, you must check the **Video** checkbox in the Sections portion of the template creation page. If this is not checked, the user sending the email will not have an opportunity to select a video, and the placeholders will not have anything to populate.

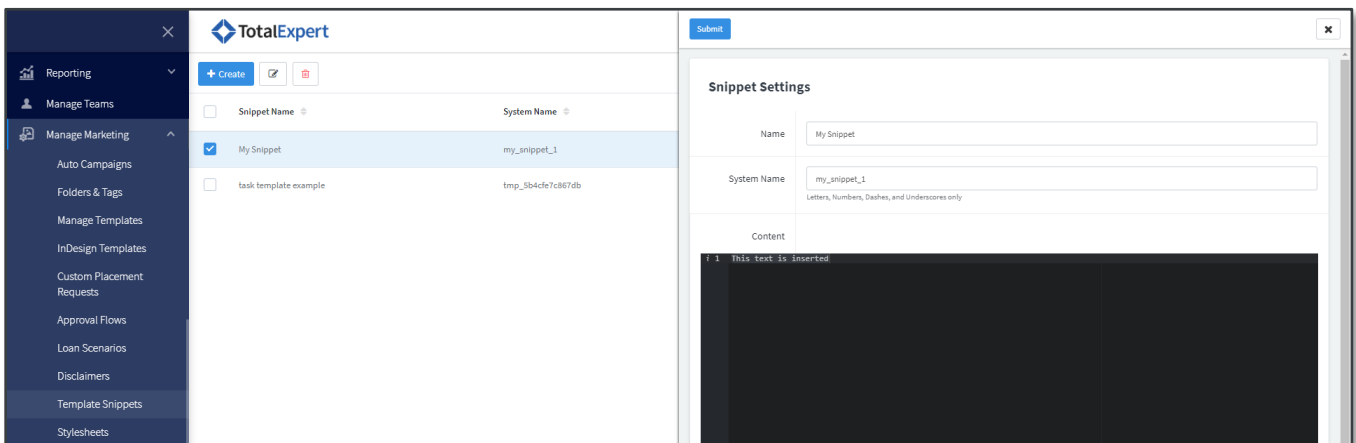

## Custom Placeholders

You can specify your own placeholders to use anywhere a standard placeholder can be used. Navigate to **Manage Marketing → Template Snippets** and click the **+Create** button. Specify a human-readable Name, a System Name, and the Content that you want to appear when the placeholder is used. In the example below, the Name is **My Snippet** and the system name is **my\_snippet\_1**.

For example, if you create the custom template snippet above, it will show in the Insert template drop-down menu as *User Snippet – My Snippet* and the actual placeholder will be `{{ sender.snippets.my_snippet_1.content }}`.
